- 3) The arrangement with North Florida Motocross Park has been discontinued.

- 5) Glen St. Mary's property ("GSM"). This property is owned by Baker County and we have secured permission to establish motorcycle trails. Mundy is working with the on-site manager Tom. When developed, it will be open to the public but club members will not have to pay. No hunting on the property. Motorcycles do not need to have license tags or Florida green stickers.
  - a. GSM is open to the public 7 days a week but occasionally closed when it floods. Closings are posted on the website. Check before you go. Better check on the GSM website than on Facebook.
  - b. The site at this time has about 25 miles of two-directional trails for off highway vehicles and equestrian trails. It has parking areas and picnic and restroom facilities. Mundy has scouted the area and has a plan for a new set of trails which will be motorcycle-only and uni-directional.
  - c. Current charges are \$ 5.00 per vehicle plus \$ 5.00 for each OHV per day. Yearly \$ 30.00. Get pass and pay at the website or pay onsite at the kiosk. If volunteering for work, contact Mundy for free passes.
  - d. No maps are available on site, except a billboard at the kiosk at the entrance. Download and print a map before going. John Bekanich has emailed maps of the planned trail system to the members.

e. Mundy will be at GSM every weekend and sometimes during the week. Meet him on Sundays at 9 am sharp at the parking lot for instructions and waivers of the fees.
